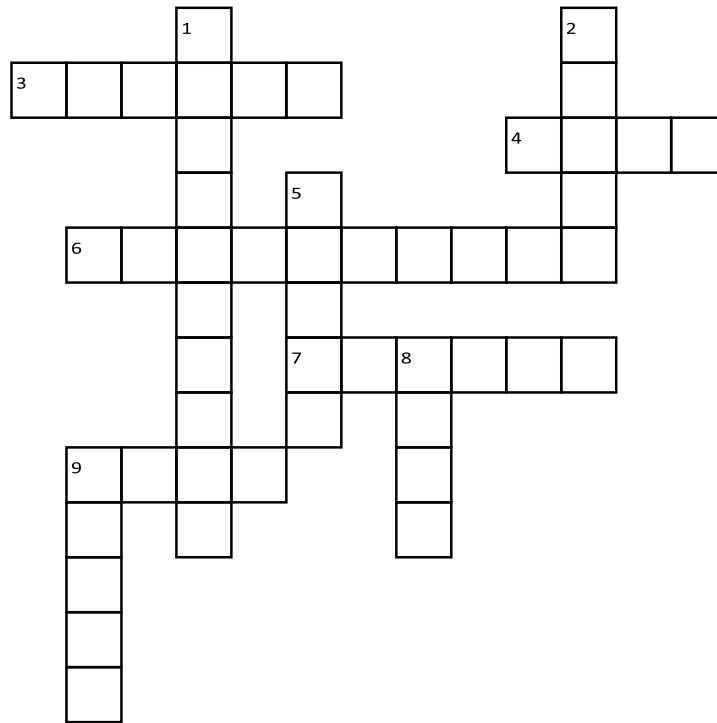




## Todd's General Store Crossword Puzzle
